In the event of an accident or emergency involving packages containing radioactive materials:

- Remove all consignment documents and emergency documents from the vehicle if possible.
- Avoid contact with the package(s) and ensure no one else comes into contact with the package(s).
- Inform the police and/or Fire Service and draw their attention to the fact that radioactive materials are involved.
- Contact HTSL on 01235 514 200
- Cordon off the vehicle, keep upwind, and prevent access except by a suitably qualified person or Emergency Services personnel.
- Prevent people loitering within the vicinity of the vehicle.
- Do not move the vehicle, containers, or packages without expert advice.
- As soon as the first Police or Fire Service officer arrives, make yourself known to them them and ensure they are advised that your vehicle is carrying radioactive material. Pass them the Instructions is Writing and the Tremcard (if carried) and any other paper work to the senior officer.
- In the event of an incident with a potential for contamination, this contamination should only be removed by a suitably qualified person or persons following consultation with HTSL. The instructions for the removal of any contaminated material should take into account the safe disposal of potentially contaminated waste produced during this action.
- Do not make any spoken or written statement to a third party or press other than briefing Emergency Services on the immediate situation. Refer them to HTSL
